## REPORTING CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT

Under Kentucky law ANY person is obligated to report child abuse, child sexual abuse, and child neglect or dependency. This means that any school staff member, any District employee, who becomes aware of abuse or neglect from any source – whether from a student, parent, staff member, or any other person – no matter if the information is oral or in written form, is obligated to report the suspected abuse or neglect.
